

# Baiter Power Kites

## Guide to flying at Baiter Park

Welcome to Baiter Park, the home of Baiter Power Kites, traction kite club. Baiter Park is the only place in Poole\Bournemouth you are allowed to traction kite. So it is important that to keep this site open for all you abide by these simple guidelines.

All flyers experienced or first timers, club member or not, all are welcome. To fly at Baiter Park you should have third party liability insurance from one of the recognised bodies PKA, PKSF (formerly BBC).

As a club, we promote safety while flying. For various reasons we don't have the entire park to fly-in. Below is a map of Baiter Park. We are permitted to fly within the black outlined area. You are asked not to fly outside of this area. This is the flying area the council has asked to stay within for all flyers alike not just club members.



Please follow these simple rules, abiding by these rules will help keep Baiter Park open for all flyers.

- Do not fly outside the marked area
- Do not fly on the footpath along the sea front

- When setting up, set-up at least 3 meter away from the sea front footpath
- Do not over fly members of the public or animals.
- If you are travelling across the field and someone crosses in front of you, SLOW DOWN AND STOP IF NECESSARY.
- If a member of the public sets-up in the middle of the field, approach them and explain what is going on around them, if they won't move then live with it, it is a public field and they have a right to be there as well as you. DO NOT BUZZ THEM WITH YOUR KITE OR FLY CLOSE TO THEM
- Please do not set-up in the middle of the field, set-up along the edges, this will leave more space for flying. If you set-up with the other flyers we can look after each other equipment.
- Wear safety gear particularly head protection
- The park can become very congested with flyers during the summer, please try and take it in turns to fly and ride
- If you are downwind lower your kite or upwind raise your kite. Of course this is not always possible but if you do tangle kites and we all do it just be calm, stake out your kite and untangle your lines
- If you think you are about to collide with another buggier or boarder turn to YOUR right
- Ensure that your kite is held down when staked out and look out for people who do not see your lines
- Don't leave any litter, put it in one of the bins or take it home, if you find litter please pick it up and put it in the bins
